



LCNA CLUB CARNIVAL - GENERAL INFORMATION

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1. Please check-in and collect your scoresheets from the main building between 7:15-7:45am.
2. PlayHQ will be used for fixtures and scoring – no printed draws will be provided. Draws will be considered final once all teams have checked in.
3. Teams must supply their own non-playing umpire, capable of umpiring the age group they're allocated to.
4. Player Eligibility:
 - a. Players must have a valid Netball NSW Membership to participate in the LCNA Club Carnival (i.e. they must be currently registered in a Winter competition through an affiliated Association such as Liverpool City).
 - b. Players not currently registered but wanting to play are required to complete a "1 Day Rego" prior to participating, nominating the carnival date as their date of play. The link for this registration can be found on the main LCNA Club Carnival page (www.lcna.com.au/clubcarnival).
5. Team Composition:
 - a. Players do not all need to play in the same winter club team, however all players participating must be age eligible and suitable to the grade the team is nominating for/allocated to.
 - b. In the spirit of this being a club carnival, composite teams being formed should not be pseudo representative teams (i.e. merging various representative players from different teams in the same club or different clubs). In this case, teams may be moved up age groups (including on the day or the carnival) or deemed to be "invitational teams" not eligible to win their grade.
 - c. Grades 12 years and under are mixed grades, with boys eligible to participate. Grades 13 years and over are single gender grades.
6. Teams must wear a recognised uniform.
7. NO EARRINGS OR TAPED FINGERNAILS.
8. Games will be conducted as per Netball NSW Carnival Guidelines and no injury time will be played.
9. A player can only play with one team during the day.
10. Round 1 will commence at 8:30am.
11. Games will be 10 minutes each way with a two (2) minute break at half time and three (3) minutes between each round.
12. Medals will be awarded to the winners of each division.

13. The winners of each Division will be awarded on a first past the post basis. Where teams finish on an equal number of points, goals for/against (percentage) will be used to determine the winner.
14. Garbage bags will be supplied; please leave your garbage in the bins provided before you leave.
15. Games will start and finish on the buzzer.

TENTS / SHADE SHELTERS

1. The venue map shows the areas where it appropriate for teams to set up shade shelters. Tents will not be permitted in any other area.
2. Appropriate walkways to/from the courts must be maintained between tents at all times.

SCORING PROCEDURES

1. The team listed first on the draw will be responsible for scoring each match, on the official score sheet provided.
2. Pens will not be provided so each team should ensure they bring their own.
3. The winning team must return the scoresheet to the main building immediately after each game.
4. POINTS AWARDED:
 - 2 points for a win
 - 1 point for a draw
 - 2 points for a win on forfeit
 - 2 points for a bye

PARKING

1. Please follow the directions of the traffic controllers on site.
